Annual General Meeting Minutes

January 26, 2017

I. Call to Order and Introduction of Members of the Executive

Jason Lesage called to order the Annual General Meeting of the Massey Victory Heights Residents' Association (MVHRA) at 1900 on Thursday, January 26, 2017 at Mount Zion Lutheran Church, 10th Avenue at Cumberland Street, New Westminster, British Columbia.
