When to call 9-1-1? Any emergency when a person is threatening to harm themselves or another person, someone is overdosing, you're witnessing a crime in progress, or your safety is threatened.

PACT

Non-emergency

If you need police assistance and there is no emergency call 604-525-5411 or visit nwpolice.org. Many kinds of crime can be reported on our website. If you are unsure if your situation is an emergency, dial 9-1-1.

Trespassing

If someone is trespassing on private property, you can respectfully ask them to leave. If someone refuses to leave after being asked you can call the non-emergency number at 604-525-5411.

Sharps disposal
