## **9-1-1**

When to call 9-1-1? Any emergency when a person is threatening to harm themselves or another person, someone is overdosing, you're witnessing a crime in progress, or your safety is threatened.

## **Non-emergency**

If you need police assistance and there is no emergency call 604-525-5411 or visit [nwpolice.org](http://nwpolice.org). Many kinds of crime can be reported on our website. If you are unsure if your situation is an emergency, dial 9-1-1.

## **PACT**

The Peer Assisted Care Team (PACT) are a mobile, community-led team that offers support to individuals experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis. Call 778-727-3909.

## **Trespassing**

If someone is trespassing on private property, you can respectfully ask them to leave. If someone refuses to leave after being asked you can call the non-emergency number at 604-525-5411.
